<p><u>Past and Present</u></p> <p>Find a picture of a Brighton landmark from the past and compare it with one from the present.</p> <p>Write a few sentences to explain the similarities and differences. Display in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Landmark – futuristic</u></p> <p>Design and make a futuristic landmark. Think about what you would like to see built in Brighton in the future.</p> <p>Think carefully about what already exists and what you think might be missing. Bring in to school and take a photo to stick in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Grace Darling</u></p> <p>Watch Grace Darling (search Grace Darling BBC). Can you re-enact a part of the story to show the class? You might want to think about using props.</p> <p>Take a photo of yourself practising at home and stick in your Homework Book.</p>
<p><u>Entertainment in Brighton</u></p> <p>Look at ways in which people entertained themselves in Brighton in the past. Compare them with what you like to do now. This could be displayed by using pictures, a table etc.</p> <p>Display in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Artwork</u></p> <p>Look up local artists/search for local images and explore how they use art to represent Brighton. See if you can re-create one of their pieces of work. You could think about focusing on deckchairs, beach huts, pier, bandstand.</p> <p>Bring in to school and take a photo to stick in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Habitat</u></p> <p>Using a mind map, can you show what kind of habitat the Brighton beach is to creatures around us.</p> <p>Display in your Homework Book.</p>
<p><u>Research</u></p> <p>Using your knowledge of food chains from our Science lessons see if you can make your own. Can you make it longer than 4 processes?</p> <p>Display in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Create a poster advertising the ice skating at the Royal Pavilion. Use attractive text, colours and pictures. Think carefully about the words you would use to grab people's attention.</p> <p>Stick in your Homework Book.</p>	<p><u>Music</u></p> <p>Make a rap or a song about Brighton and Hove and be ready to perform to the year group. Try to include historical facts!</p> <p>Make sure it is fun and there is a copy in your Homework Book.</p>
