Design and make your own mosaic using a material of your choice. Please bring your mosaic into school and stick a photo of it in your Homework Book.</p>	<p>Roman myths are popular stories. Read a Roman myth with someone at home. Bring the myth into school to read and share with the class. You could stick a photo of yourself reading the myth in your Homework Book before you come and re-tell the story to the class at school.</p>
<p>Learn about the bones and muscles in the human body. Can you name any of them? Can you find any other interesting facts? Think of a creative way to display what you find.</p> <p><u>Or</u> you can make your own moving skeleton by requesting a skeleton template via the Homework Diary.</p>	<p>The Romans were famous for their buildings. Find out what the buildings looked like*. You could look at one of the following: Colosseum, amphitheatre or aqueducts. Cook your own healthy dish and present it to someone at home as if you were a famous chef! Don't forget to talk about why each item is healthy! Remember to stick a photo in your Homework Book.</p>
