<p>Can you write some short clues in your homework book to help us guess a toy you have at home? For example...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. I am made from plastic.</li><li>2. You can build with me.</li><li>3. I come in different colours.</li></ol> <p>I am...LEGO!</p>	<p>Design a 3D model of a toy. Bring it into school or take a photo and stick it in your homework book.</p>	<p>Set up a toy shop at home and give your toys a price tag. Take turns to play shop keeper and customer with someone at home. Take a photo of your toy shop and stick it in your homework book.</p>
<p>Find a story from home or the library about a teddy bear. Write a book review in your homework book about the story. You could draw a picture to go with it too.</p>	<p>Draw or take some photos of your favourite toys. Stick them in your homework book and write some labels for them.</p>	<p>Speak to a grandparent or older family friend and ask them what toys they enjoyed playing with when they were younger. Be ready to talk about this to the class.</p>
<p>Choose your favourite toy and try to write a short advert for it. Remember to include <b>adjectives</b> to add detail and describe e.g. A speedy track. Bright red racing cars.</p>	<p>Look in your garden or park at the different plants that you can see. Can you draw it in your homework book and label the different parts?</p>	<p>Can you find a poem about Spring and learn it off by heart? Be ready to perform the poem to the rest of the class.</p>
