








The Site

Groups

Groupings are arranged nearer the time, with input from staff and consideration of friendships.

We don't hype these up or tell the children before we arrive as we don't want it to be the focus.

Dorm and activity groups are often different to encourage the children to mix with each other.





What's included?

- ✓ Transport, including ferry crossing

Cost?

Approximately £550 per person, depending on final numbers.
