<p>Write some short clues in your homework book to help others guess a wild animal you are interested in. For example...</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. I have black and white fur.</li> <li>2. I live in China.</li> <li>3. I eat bamboo.</li> <li>4. I am endangered.</li> </ol>	<p>Create a 3D model of your favourite habitat e.g. desert, rainforest, woodland, polar desert. Bring it into school or take a photo and stick it in your homework book.</p>	<p>Create a short dance about your favourite wild animal. Think about how the animal moves and what the animal does. Your parent could video your dance and email the recording to the office so that it can be shared with the class.</p>
<p>Find a story from home or the library about the Earth. Write a book review in your homework book about the story. You could draw a picture to go with it too.</p>	<p>Find a picture of a wild animal. Stick it in your homework book and write some labels for them. Your labels could include facts about their appearance or habitat.</p>	<p>Speak to a grandparent or older family friend and ask them about a place that they have travelled to. Ask them to share what they saw and what they liked about the place. Be ready to talk about this with the class.</p>
<p>Choose your favourite holiday destination and try to write a short advert for it. Remember to include <b>adjectives</b> to add detail and describe the destination e.g. Rome is a <u>busy</u> city. It has lots of <u>famous</u> landmarks.</p>	<p>Look in your garden or park at the different plants that you can see. Can you draw it in your homework book and label the different parts?</p>	<p>Can you find a poem about Spring and learn it off by heart? Be ready to perform the poem to the rest of the class.</p>
