Science – What plants do you eat?

In our daily diets, humans eat lots of plants. List the plants you and your family have eaten in one week. Present your work neatly and add captions and drawings too.

Science – Growing and looking after plants

Make a cress head. You might want to look these up online as there are many different varieties. Please keep a log/diary of the growth progress. We would love to have the finished products in school before you give them a haircut.



Romans - Step into a Roman's Shoes!

Choose a Roman character you would like to be such as a soldier, chariot racer, Roman citizen, gladiator, or emperor/empress, and imagine a short scene or story about them, thinking about what they are doing, how they feel and what they might say. Then show your scene in a creative way by acting it out for your family using voices and actions. Draw a storyboard or send a video in.

Science – Gardening

Spend some time looking after your garden/plants. Help someone at home to maintain it/them. This could include lots of different jobs. We would love to see photo evidence of it in your Homework Book. Can you name any of the plants in your garden?

Art – Artist focus

In Art, we will be learning about a different artist each week, learning about their styles and techniques and recreating a piece of art in their style. Choose an artist to research and recreate your own piece of artwork inspired by them. This can be your own interpretation of a famous piece, using techniques created by them or simply using a similar colour palette to the one they use.

Art - Jump into a painting!

Pick a famous painting that you like and become it! Pretend you are the people, animals, or objects in the picture and act out the scene. We can't wait to see you strike a pose! Ask a grown-up to take a photo of you being the painting and send it in or print it off to show the class your masterpiece.

Romans - Super Romans Assemble!

Invent a Roman superhero – maybe a soldier with a super shiny shield or an emperor who can fly. Write 3–5 sentences about what your superhero can do and what adventures they have. Draw your superhero in action!

Romans - Battle ready and Brilliant

Get ready to be a Roman warrior! Design your very own super-cool Roman shield – the brighter and bolder the better! Add patterns, colours and fun details like a smiling lion or dancing chariot and make a shield you'd be proud to carry into battle.



Science - Sprout, Stretch, Shine!

Imagine you are a plant seed and act out how you grow. Start as a tiny seed in the soil, then sprout and push up through the ground, grow leaves and a stem, and finally bloom into a flower or grow fruit. Show how the sun, water and wind help you grow. Ask a grown-up to take a photo or short video of you acting out your plant, or you can draw yourself as the plant in each stage.
