- Egyptian Gods and Pharaohs including Tutankhamun.
- Mummification and the Afterlife.

Music

- Songs and rounds to develop singing range.
- Recorder pieces on 5 notes, reading from notation.
- Note values, dynamics, rests, bar lines.
- Creating Orff ensembles.

PE

- Games – to develop catching and throwing, batting within striking games. Learning the rules of the games.
- Athletics – introduction to running, jumping and throwing events.
- Swimming – develop stroke technique and water skills.

PSHE

- Feeling Good, Feeling Safe.
- Sharing, generosity.
- Charitable Giving.
- Environment - focus on water.
- Transition to Year 4.

Religious Studies

- Understanding Ancient Egyptian Beliefs.
- The stories of Joseph and Moses.
- The Israelites Exodus from Egypt.
